

# Prop 65 – Best Practice for Catalog Content

- The goal of the Best Practices Recommendation is to inform, assist and provide recommendations on transmission and display of Regulatory online content for Auto Care Association members.
- The scope of the Best Practice is focused solely on the process to deliver and process regulatory information for online display purposes.
- Regulatory content must be delivered in a consistent location and format within the PIES product information exchange file. This is intended to facilitate the implementation of the Suppliers content by the Receivers through the standardization of content and delivery.

# Prop 65 – Best Practice for Catalog Content

Auto Care Association Technology Standards Committee approved the following guidelines to convey data required for Prop 65 compliance.

- Send Prop 65 text label as an attribute using the PIES Attribute Segment
  - F05 / ATRB / Attribute ID (Type) / AN1/80 / When Element F07 is set to 'N', the user will send a unique user defined Attribute Label defined in Alphanumeric Format of up to 80 Characters
  - F10 / ATRB / Attribute Data / AN1/2000 / Required if "Attribute ID (Type)" specified. Supplier assigned value corresponding to "Attribute ID"
- Send applicable image using the PIES Asset Segment
  - PIES 7.0 (available now) - New Asset Type Codes for Digital Assets and Market Digital Assets (P10 and M10) have been added (P65 and RGL)
