Dear Mr. President:

The Automotive Aftermarket Suppliers Association (AASA) and The Auto Care Association represents automotive aftermarket parts manufacturers, retailers, distributors, and service repair facilities in the United States. This industry employs over 4.7 million Americans nationwide and provides parts and services for the more than 280 million car and trucks on American roads. These vehicles enable our nation to function during the current COVID-19 pandemic. On behalf of these hard-working Americans employed in our industry, we would like to thank you for your strong leadership during our current national crisis.

This industry and its workforce face an immediate crisis that needs your leadership. Aftermarket manufacturers, distributors, and repair facilities want to provide these essential services, but are facing inconsistent state emergency designations of essential personnel and services. These businesses were deemed critical in the March 19 MEMORANDUM ON IDENTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE WORKERS DURING COVID-19 RESPONSE issued by Director Christopher Krebs of the Department of Homeland Security.

Since automotive and transportation repair businesses have thus far been designated as essential in all states issuing emergency guidelines, **it is necessary to also designate the manufacturers and distributors** of the parts used to service these establishments as essential so they can continue to manufacture and deliver parts to keep these essential businesses operating. Without a flow of these parts and components, emergency vehicles and essential health care and public safety workers could be left stranded and unable to travel to work.

We urge the White House to initiate a consistent national policy to keep the entire auto care industry open which includes part manufacturers, retailers, distributors and service facilities of cars, trucks, and commercial vehicles. By allowing these businesses to stay open, these workers will provide a vital service and necessary revenue for communities throughout the country.

AASA and The Auto Care Association strongly supports your emergency efforts to assist the country and our industry stands ready to help in any way.
